Introduction

Good morning everyone.

I hope everyone is gearing up for Christmas and the New Year!



Two Recent Projects

In 2023 we have undertaken two huge tasks:

- referencing Birth, Death and Marriage (BDM references for all relevant members of the Fahey Family Tree (FFT) and [website](#); and
- correcting the inaccurate birth dates of James Fahey and Timothy Fahey.

a) BDM Process

As some of you might know we have been working on the Birth Death & Marriage (BDM) references for our Fahey Family Tree.

The latest “Tree” was taken as a starting point - a “Tree” being the one page document with the parents as the focus and the children & their partners, if applicable, on the right of the page.

The process used follows:

1. Taking a screenshot of the listed BDM on the “Tree”.
2. Searching for other BDMs not listed.
3. Note: BDMs are not currently available for:
 1. Births after 01/01/1923 (100 years);
 2. Marriages after 01/01/1973 (50 years); and
 3. Deaths after 01/01/1993 (30 years).
4. Creating a screenshot link to the BDM reference on the individual’s webpage.
5. Uploading the screenshot to the individual’s webpage - the data may also reveal the parents’ names for instance or a second given name.
6. Updating the individual’s electronic folder with the screenshot - again, this may need to be updated because of extra information eg second given name, year of birth or death.
7. Updating the Spreadsheet containing the main data of all descendants.
8. Updating the Tree document: note that all BDM’s that have been accessed and uploaded now appear in red (for NSW).
9. Uploading the updated Tree to the website.
10. Updating the iCloud folders:
 1. Trees (“5 Trees via Word”);

2. the individuals' electronic folders ("1 Individuals"); and
3. the updated Spreadsheet ("6 Spreadsheet").

It's taken a while but the process is now complete! However, from 1 January we will be able to obtain "next year's lot"!

b) James Fahey and Timothy Fahey

A small team of "sleuths" were consulted – Charlene Rigby, Christine Glover, Peter Hainsworth, Susan Hartley, Catherine Ryan, Michelle Maunder, Gaye Keir and Terry Flowers.

We decided that James was born in 1823 and Timothy in 1825 meaning that we had to reorder a lot of the data in the [website](#), spreadsheet, Trees, Tables, Folders and spreadsheet.

The consequential changes needed were to:

- change each webpage FFT# for the 5s and 6s;
- change each reference to the six brothers and links to the respective pages for James and Timothy;
- update each Tree for the 5s and 6s;
- renumber and reposition the lists of individuals in the tables for the 5s and 6s;
- re-number the individual folders for the 5s and 6s;
- re-number the individuals in the Excel spreadsheet for the 5s and 6s; and
- update all of the data on iCloud.

It was appreciated that Cathy kindly gave assistance in completing the task!

As always please let me know if you identify any errors. Thanks.

Finally, spare a thought for Terry Flowers. His FFT# changed from 6.5.1.1.1A to 5.5.1.1.1A!
